Sensory Organ

- Sense organs have highly specialised nerve cells, which receive stimuli and convert them into appropriate nerve impulses.
- These nerve impulses are carried to the CNS by afferent or sensory nerve fibres.
- sense organs (eyes, ears, tongue, skin, and nose) contain receptors that relay information through sensory neurons to appropriate places within the nervous system.

Following organs are known as sense organs:

1) **Tongue (Taste Bud of Tongue):** To sense the taste.

2) **Eye:** To sense the colour and light.

3) **Nose:** To sense the smell and odour.

4) **Ear:** To sense the sound.

5) **Skin:** To sense the touch, pressure, temperature, and pain.

- Tongue is a muscular organ located in the front of the mouth, which helps in chewing and swallowing of food.
- The surface of tongue is covered with small bumps called taste buds, which are considered as the organ of taste.
- Each taste bud contains five types of taste receptors.
- Tongue is covered with a thin layer called tongue epithelium, which is covered with the taste buds.
