What Is a Population?

- is a group of organisms of the same species that live in a specific geographical area and interbreed.
- A population is a reproductive group because organisms usually breed with members of their own population.
- The word population refers to the group in general and also to the size of the population, or the ______ it contains.

Properties of Populations

- is the number of individuals of the same species in that live in a given unit of area.
- is the pattern of distribution of organisms in a population. A population's dispersion may be even, clumped, or random.
- Size, density, dispersion, and other properties can be used to describe populations and to predict changes within them.

How Does a Population Grow?

- A population gains individuals with each new offspring or birth and loses them with each death.
- The resulting population change over time can be represented by the equation below.



How Does a Population Grow?

- is an expression of the increase in the size of an organism or population over a given period of time. It is the birth rate minus the death rate.
- Overtime, the growth rates of populations change because birth rates and death rates increase or decrease.
