Goldfinger not only covers the anatomy of the more common animals such as the horse, dog, cat, cow, pig, squirrel and rabbit but also the anatomy of numerous wild species including the lion, giraffe, deer, hippopotamus, rhinoceros, elephant, gorilla, sea lion and bear. Included are drawings of skeletons and how they move at the joints, individual muscles showing their attachments on the skeleton, muscles of the entire animal, cross sections, photographs of live animals and silhouettes of related animals comparing their shapes and proportions. He offers a new and innovative section on the basic body plan of four legged animals giving the reader a crucial conceptual understanding of overall animal structure to which the details of individual animals can then be applied. The chapter on birds covers the skeleton, muscles and feather patterns. The appendix presents photographs of skulls with magnificent horns and antlers and a section on major surface veins.
