DYNAMIC!

- longer than width (FEMUR, HUMERUS, RADIUS, ULNA, TIBIA, FIBULA)
- "FLAT" (PARIETALS, OCCIPITAL, PTERION, NASAL)
- "IRREGULARLY" shaped (CLAVICLE & COMPLEX SHAPES (VERTEBRAL, COCCYX, PELVIS))
- about as long as they are wide (CARPALS, METACARPALS, PATELLA)
- irregular (PATELLA "KNEECAP")
- they grow, send in tendrils of new matter
