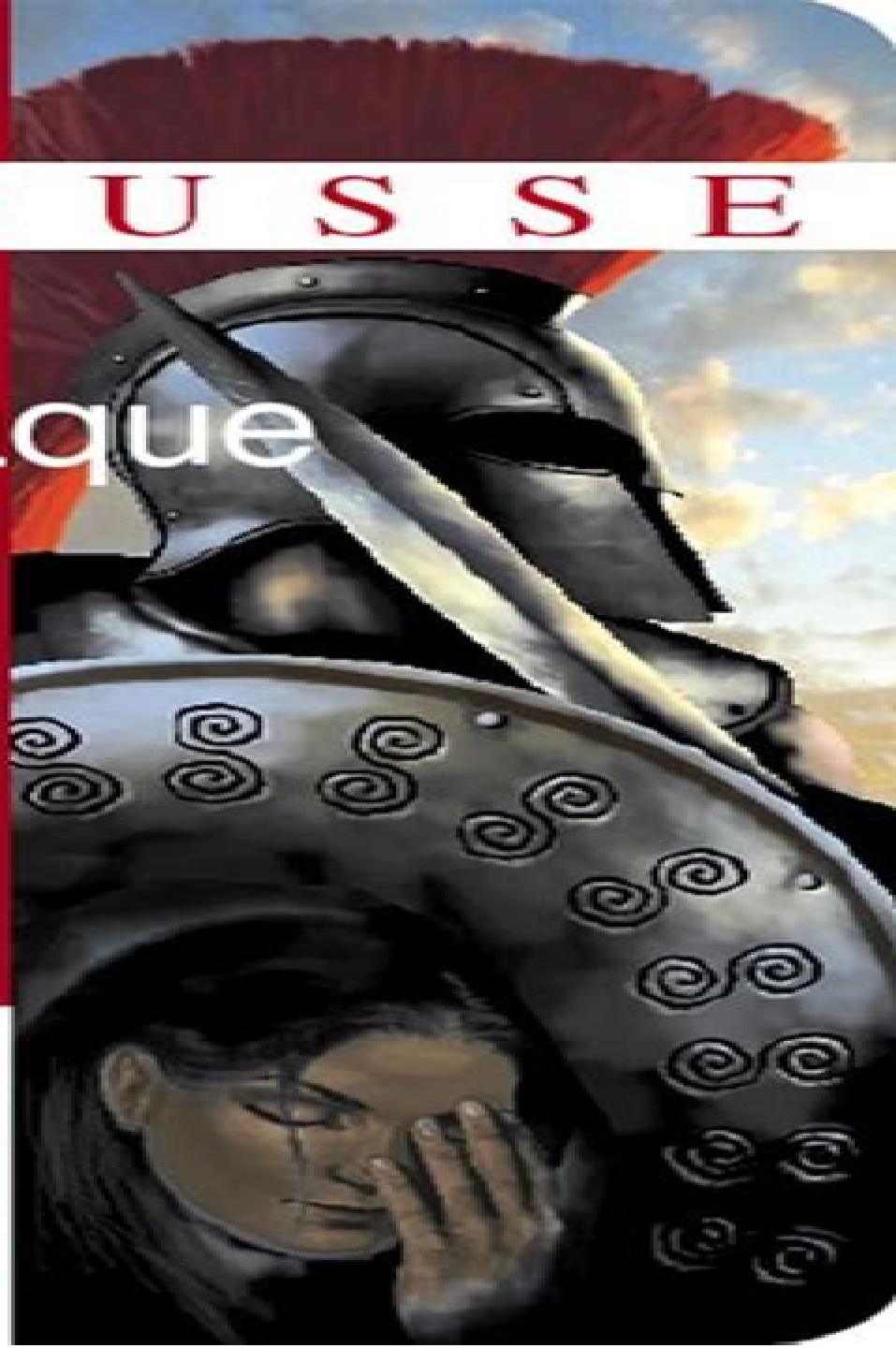

and the house of Peleus father of Achilles Although Neoptolemus is murdered the play ends with a prophecy for the future of the line of descent of Peleus and Thetis in the form of the blessed kingdom of Molossia **French News**, 1964 *French Literature* John D.
