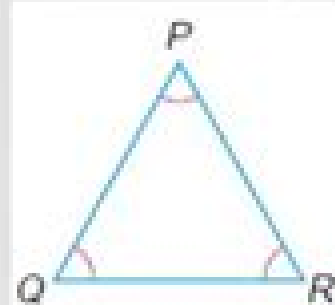


Two column proof
