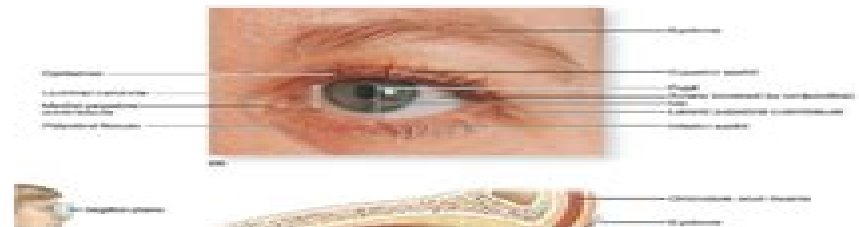

3. LACRIMAL APPARATUS (FIG. 19.10)

Produces/collects tears (lacrimal fluid)

1. **Lacrimal Gland:** produces and secretes tears
2. *(Fluid is swept across the surface of the eye by the eyelids)*
3. **Lacrimal canaliculi:** from **lacrimal puncta** to **nasolacrimal duct**
4. **Nasolacrimal duct:** drains tears into nasal cavity, where they are eventually swallowed
