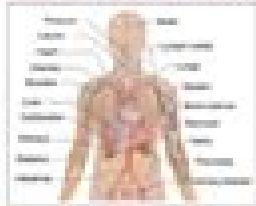
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HUMAN ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY

Study of the human organism and its internal body



Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its internal organs.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its internal organs.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves the study of the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the human body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of the cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of the tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of the organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of the systems.
- 6. **Organism level** - study of the structure and function of the whole organism.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids.

1. **Intracellular fluid** - fluid inside the cell.

2. **Extracellular fluid** - fluid outside the cell.

3. **Interstitial fluid** - fluid between the cells.

4. **Plasma** - fluid in the blood.

5. **Lymph** - fluid in the lymphatic system.

6. **Transudate** - fluid that leaks out of blood vessels.

7. **Exudate** - fluid that leaks out of blood vessels due to inflammation.

8. **Secretions** - fluids produced by cells.

9. **Sweat** - fluid produced by sweat glands.

10. **Tears** - fluid produced by tear glands.

11. **Saliva** - fluid produced by salivary glands.

12. **Urine** - fluid produced by the kidneys.

13. **Feces** - solid waste produced by the digestive system.

14. **Other fluids** - various other fluids produced by the body.

15. **Amniotic fluid** - fluid surrounding the fetus in the uterus.

16. **Peritoneal fluid** - fluid in the peritoneal cavity.

17. **Cerebrospinal fluid** - fluid in the brain and spinal cord.

18. **Synovial fluid** - fluid in the joints.

19. **Other fluids** - various other fluids produced by the body.

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CELLS

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.

1. **Prokaryotic cells** - cells without a nucleus.

2. **Eukaryotic cells** - cells with a nucleus.

3. **Animal cells** - cells without cell walls.

4. **Plant cells** - cells with cell walls.

5. **Fungal cells** - cells with cell walls.

6. **Bacterial cells** - cells without a nucleus.

7. **Viral cells** - cells without a nucleus.

8. **Protozoan cells** - cells without a nucleus.
