c. There is a pre-Christmas spurt in production and sales and a January slackening. This normal seasonal variation does not signal boom or recession. From decade to decade, the long-term trend (the secular trend) of the S.A. economy has been upward. A period with no GDP growth thus does not mean all is normal, but that the economy is operating below its trend growth of output.

d. Because capital goods and durable goods last, purchases can be postponed. This may happen when a recession is forecast. Capital goods and durable goods industries therefore suffer large output declines during recessions. In contrast, consumers cannot postpone buying nondurables such as food; therefore, recessions only slightly reduce nondurable output. Also, capital goods and durable goods expenditures tend to be "lumpy." Usually, a large expenditure is needed to purchase them, and this shrinks to zero after the purchase is made.
