 Understanding: Between 1607 and 1763, the British North American colonies gained experience
 in, and the expectation of, self-government in the development of political, religious, economic

- 3. Early National Period through Era of Good Feelings; (3 weeks-Chapters 7-9-pages 191-257). Enduring Understandings: Between 1789 and 1820, conflict over the increasing power of the national government created intensified sectional tension. Between 1789 and 1823, geographic isolation allowed the United States to pursue a policy of selective involvement in world affairs. Topics: federalism, first American party system, Hamilton's economic plan, neutrality and foreign policy, Jeffersonian democracy, Supreme court cases, territorial expansion, freedom of the seas, War of 1812, convention system, national market economy, industrial revolution, transportation revolution, agricultural revolution, nationalism, sectionalism, Ear of Good Feelings.
