 - Flat bones (ie scapulae / sternum)
 - Irregular (ie vertebrae / facial bones)
 - Sesamoid (ie patella)
- Long bone anatomy -----
 - Epiphyseal plate: site of growth, containing hyaline cartilage
 - Epiphysis: wide end portions of the bone. Red marrow at the ends, spongy bone
 - Diaphysis: long middle portion of the bone
 - Endosteum: inner membrane lining of medullary cavity
 - Medullary cavity: site of bone growth / repair
 - Periosteum: outer bone lining. Also has blood vessels and nerves, and attachment site for ligaments / tendons
 - Articular cartilage: covers the ends of bones that participate in joints
