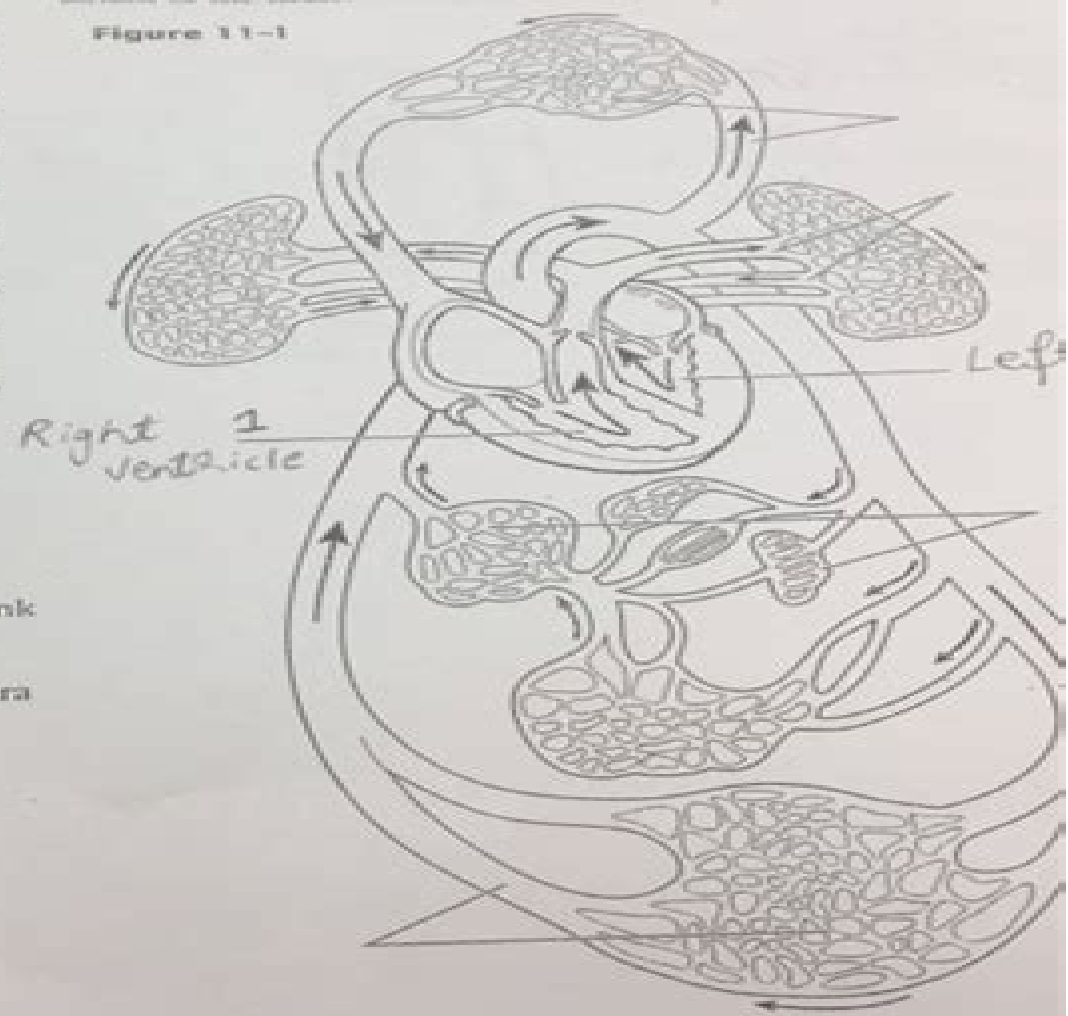

health and disease depend as this knowledge will be required in practice in after life It is somewhat unaccountable says Dr Dick and not a little inconsistent that while we direct the young to look abroad over the surface of the earth and survey its mountains rivers seas and continents and guide their views to the regions of the firmament where they may contemplate the moons of Jupiter the rings of Saturn and thousands of luminaries placed at immeasurable distances that we should never teach them to look into themselves to consider their own corporeal structures the numerous parts of which they are composed the admirable functions they perform the wisdom and goodness displayed in their mechanism and the lessons of practical instruction which may be derived from such contemplations Again he says One great practical end which should always be kept in view in the study of physiology is the invigoration and improvement of the corporeal powers and functions the preservation of health and the prevention of disease
