Oriola, 2016-05-13 Crude oil extraction in the Niger Delta region of Nigeria generates 96% of all foreign earnings and 85% of state revenues making it crucial to the survival of the Nigerian state Several generations of state neglect corruption and mismanagement have ensured that the Delta region is
