Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology

Definition: The study of the structure and function of the human body.

Branches:

- Anatomy:** The study of the structure of the body.
- Physiology:** The study of the function of the body.

Levels of Organization:

1. Chemical level
2. Cellular level
3. Tissue level
4. Organ level
5. Organ system level
6. Organism level

Homeostasis

Definition: The process by which the body maintains a stable internal environment.

Components:

- Sensors:** Detect changes in the environment.
- Integrating Centers:** Process information and initiate a response.
- Effectors:** Carry out the response.

Types of Homeostasis:

- Thermoregulation:** Maintaining body temperature.
- Glucose Regulation:** Maintaining blood sugar levels.
- Water Balance:** Maintaining fluid volume.

Cell Structure

Cell: The basic unit of life.

Parts of a Cell:

- Cell Membrane:** The boundary of the cell.
- Nucleus:** The control center of the cell.
- Mitochondria:** The powerhouses of the cell.
- Ribosomes:** Sites of protein synthesis.
- Endoplasmic Reticulum:** The site of protein and lipid synthesis.

Integumentary System

Functions:

- 1. Protection
- 2. Regulation of body temperature
- 3. Sensation
- 4. Excretion
- 5. Synthesis of vitamin D

Components:

- Skin:** The largest organ of the body.
- Hair:** Made of keratin.
- Nails:** Made of keratin.

Muscular System

Functions:

- 1. Movement
- 2. Posture
- 3. Heat production

Types of Muscles:

- Skeletal:** Attached to bones.
- Cardiac:** Found in the heart.
- Smooth:** Found in internal organs.

Nervous System

Functions:

- 1. Control and coordination
- 2. Sensation
- 3. Response

Parts:

- Brain:** The control center.
- Spinal Cord:** Transmits signals.
- Nerves:** Carry signals to and from the brain.

Endocrine System

Functions:

- 1. Regulation of metabolism
- 2. Growth and development
- 3. Reproduction

Hormones: Chemical messengers.

Respiratory System

Functions:

- 1. Gas exchange
- 2. pH balance

Parts:

- Lungs:** Sites of gas exchange.
- Trachea:** Windpipe.
- Diaphragm:** Muscular partition.

Cardiovascular System

Functions:

- 1. Transport of oxygen and nutrients
- 2. Removal of waste products

Parts:

- Heart:** The pump.
- Blood Vessels:** Carry blood.

Digestive System

Functions:

- 1. Breakdown of food
- 2. Absorption of nutrients

Parts:

- Mouth:** Entry point.
- Stomach:** Digestion.
- Intestines:** Absorption.



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Reproductive System

Functions:

- 1. Production of gametes
- 2. Fertilization

Parts:

- Ovaries:** Produce eggs.
- Testes:** Produce sperm.

Urinary System

Functions:

- 1. Filtration of blood
- 2. Regulation of fluid balance

Parts:

- Kidneys:** Filter blood.
- Ureters:** Carry urine.
- Bladder:** Store urine.

Immune System

Functions:

- 1. Defense against pathogens
- 2. Healing

Parts:

- White Blood Cells:** Fight infection.
- Lymphatic System:** Circulate fluids.

Skeletal System

Functions:

- 1. Support
- 2. Protection
- 3. Movement

Parts:

- Bones:** Provide structure.
- Joints:** Allow movement.
