Calculations in Analytical Chemistry

The Mole

The mole is the SI unit for amount of substance. It corresponds to the amount of a chemical substance that contains the same number of particles present in 12 grams of C-12 which is equivalent to Avogadro's number, that is, NA=6.022X10^23.

The molar mass is given as the mass of a compound in grams per mole of that substance. It is calculated by adding the molar masses of all the component elements in the compound. Take glucose for example:

Element	Molar mass per element	Number of atoms	Mass
С	12 g/mol	6	72 g/mol
н	1 g/mol	12	12g/m
0	16 g/mol	6	96 g/mol
Molar Mass			180 g/mol

Mole and Millimole Calculations

The millimole is simply 1/1000 of a mole. It is sometimes used in calculations because of its convenience.

Example (Skoog, et al., 2014):

 Find the number of moles and millimoles of benzoic acid (122.1 g/mol) that are contained in 2.00 g of pure acid.

If we use HBz to represent benzoic acid:

$$HBz_{mol} = 2.00 \frac{g_{HBz}}{g_{HBz}} \times \frac{1mol_{HBz}}{122.1 \frac{g_{HBz}}{g_{HBz}}} = 0.0164 mol_{HBz}$$

To obtain the number of milimoles, the millimolar mass of benzoic acid will be used:

$$HBz_{mol} = 2.00 \frac{g_{HBz}}{g_{HBz}} \times \frac{1mmol_{HBz}}{0.1221 \frac{g_{HBz}}{g_{HBz}}} = 16.4mmol_{HBz}$$
