Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its parts.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its parts.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves understanding the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of body systems.
- 6. **Whole body level** - study of the structure and function of the entire human body.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.

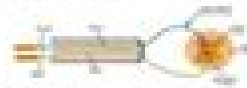


Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Intracellular fluid** - fluid inside the cell.
- 2. **Extracellular fluid** - fluid outside the cell.
- 3. **Interstitial fluid** - fluid between cells.
- 4. **Plasma** - fluid in the blood.
- 5. **Lymph** - fluid in the lymphatic system.

The fluid inside the cell is called intracellular fluid, and the fluid outside the cell is called extracellular fluid.



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ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different types of tissues.

Organs are composed of different types of tissues, including:

- 1. **Epithelial tissue** - covers the body.
- 2. **Connective tissue** - supports the body.
- 3. **Muscle tissue** - contracts to move the body.
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SYSTEMS

Systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a function.

Systems are composed of different types of organs, including:

- 1. **Cardiovascular system** - transports blood.
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NERVOUS SYSTEM

Neurons

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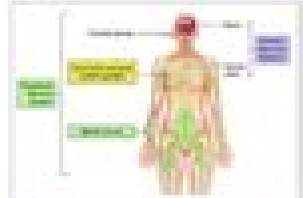
- 1. **Cell body** - contains the nucleus.
- 2. **Dendrites** - receive information.
- 3. **Axon** - carries information.
- 4. **Myelin sheath** - insulates the axon.

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FUNCTIONS OF THE BODY

The body performs various functions, including:

- 1. **Protection** - defends the body from harm.
- 2. **Support** - maintains the body's structure.
- 3. **Transport** - moves substances throughout the body.
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EXCRETORY SYSTEM

The excretory system removes waste from the body.

- 1. **Glomerulus** - filters blood.
- 2. **Proximal convoluted tubule** - reabsorbs substances.
- 3. **Distal convoluted tubule** - secretes substances.
- 4. **Collecting duct** - carries urine.
