Chapter 12

Sensory Organ

- Sense organs have highly specialised nerve cells, which receive stimuli and convert them into appropriate nerve impulses.
- These nerve impulses are carried to the CNS by afferent or sensory nerve fibres.
- sense organs (eyes, ears, tongue, skin, and nose) contain receptors that relay information through sensory neurons to appropriate places within the nervous system.

Following organs are known as sense organs:

1) **Tongue (Taste Bud of Tongue):** To sense the taste.

2) **Eye:** To sense the light and colour.

3) **Ear:** To sense the sound and vibration and sense of hearing.

4) **Nose:** To sense the smell.

5) **Skin:** To sense the touch, pressure, temperature, pain, and other sensations.

Organ of Taste (Tongue)

- Tongue is a muscular organ located in the front of the mouth, which helps in chewing and swallowing of food.
- The surface of tongue is covered with the papillae and taste buds. It is considered as the organ of taste.
- Papillae are small, fleshy projections on the tongue.
- Tongue is covered with papillae, which are covered with the taste buds.
- Each papilla contains many taste buds. Each taste bud contains five taste hairs.
- Each taste hair is a long, thin, hair-like structure, which is called the taste hair.
