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America's New Empire Richard F. Hamilton, 2017-07-05 In this volume Hamilton deals with some of the antecedents and the outcome of the Spanish American war specifically the acquisition of an American empire It critiques the progressive view of those events questioning the notion that businessmen and compliant politicians aggressively sought new markets particularly those of Asia Hamilton shows that United States exports continued to go predominantly to the major European nations The progressive tradition has focused on empire specifically on the Philippines depicted as a stepping stone to the China market Hamilton shows that the Asian market remained minuscule in the following decades and that other historical works have neglected the most important change in the nation's trade pattern the growth of the Canada market which two decades after the 1898 war became the United States largest foreign market The book begins with a review and criticism of the basic assumptions of the progressive framework These are first that the nation is ruled by big business political leaders being compliant co workers Second that those businessmen are zealous profit seekers And third that they are well informed rational decision makers A further underlying assumption is that the economy was not functioning well in the 1890s and that a need for new markets was recognized as an urgent necessity so that big business accordingly demanded world power and empire Each of these assumptions pivotal elements in the dominant progressive tradition in historical writing is challenged with an alternative viewpoint presented Hamilton presents a different more complex view of the events following the Spanish American War The class dominance theory is not supported The alternative argued here elitism proves appropriate and more useful This review and assessment of arguments about American expansion in the 1890s adds much to the literature of the period

Plains provides the basis for an understanding of homesteading that is startlingly different from current scholarly orthodoxy

Pérez Jr., 2000-11-09 A century after the Cuban war for independence was fought Louis Pérez examines the meaning of the war of 1898 as represented in one hundred years of American historical writing Offering both a critique of the conventional historiography and an alternate history of the war informed by Cuban sources Pérez explores the assumptions that have shaped our understanding of the Spanish American War a construct he argues that denies the Cubans participation in their own struggle for liberation from Spanish rule Pérez examines historical accounts of the destruction of the battleship Maine the representation of public opinion as a precipitant of war and the treatment of the military campaign in Cuba Equally important he shows how historical narratives have helped sustain notions of America's national purpose and policy many of which were first articulated in 1898 Cuba insinuated itself into one of the most important chapters of US history and what happened on the island in the final decade of the nineteenth century and the way in which what happened was subsequently represented has had far reaching implications many of which continue to resonate today

Beyond 1492 James Axtell, 1992 In this provocative and timely collection of essays five published for the first time one of the most important ethnohistorians writing today James Axtell explores the key role of imagination both in our perception of strangers and in the writing of history Coinciding with the 500th anniversary of Columbus's discovery of America this collection covers a wide range of topics dealing with American history Three essays view the invasion of North America from the perspective of the Indians whose land it was The very first meetings he finds were nearly always peaceful Other essays describe native encounters with colonial traders creating the first consumer revolution and Jesuit missionaries in Canada and Mexico Despite the tragedy of many of the encounters Axtell also finds that there was much humor in Indian European negotiations over peace sex and war In the final section he conducts searching analyses of how college textbooks treat the initial century of American history how America's human face changed from all brown in 1492 to predominantly white and black by 1792 and how we handled moral questions during the

Quincentenary He concludes with an extensive review of the Quincentenary scholarship books films TV and museum exhibits and suggestions for how we can assimilate what we have learned

Neighbors and Strangers Bruce H. Mann, 2016-06-30 Combining legal and social history Bruce Mann explores the relationship between law and society from the mid seventeenth century to the eve of the Revolution Analyzing a sample of more than five thousand civil cases from the records of local courts in Connecticut he shows how once neighborly modes of disputing yielded to a legal system that treated neighbors and strangers alike During the colonial period population growth immigration economic development war and religious revival transformed the nature and context of official and economic relations in Connecticut Towns lost the insularity and homogeneity that made them the embodiment of community Debt litigation was transformed from a communal model of disputing in which procedures were based on the individual disagreements to a system of mechanical rules that homogenized law Pleading grew more technical and the civil jury faded from predominance to comparative insignificance Arbitration and church disciplinary proceedings the usual alternatives to legal process became more formal and legalistic and ultimately less communal Using a computer assisted analysis of court records and insights drawn from anthropology and sociology Mann concludes that changes in the law and its applications were tied to the growing commercialization of the economy They also can be attributed to the fledgling legal profession s approach to law as an autonomous system rather than as a communal process These changes marked the advent of a legal system that valued predictability and uniformity of legal relations more than responsiveness to individual communities Mann shows that by the eve of the Revolution colonial law had become less identified with community and more closely associated with society

Land Too Good for Indians John P. Bowes, 2016-05-10 The history of Indian removal has often followed a single narrative arc one that begins with President Andrew Jackson s Indian Removal Act of 1830 and follows the Cherokee Trail of Tears In that conventional account the Black Hawk War of 1832 encapsulates the experience of tribes in the territories north of the Ohio River But Indian removal in the Old Northwest was much more complicated involving many Indian peoples and more than just one policy event or politician In *Land Too Good for Indians* historian John P Bowes takes a long needed closer more expansive look at northern Indian removal and in so doing amplifies the history of Indian removal and of the United States Bowes focuses on four case studies that exemplify particular elements of removal in the Old Northwest He traces the paths taken by Delaware Indians in response to Euro American expansion and U S policies in the decades prior to the Indian Removal Act He also considers the removal experience among the Seneca Cayugas Wyandots and other Indian communities in the Sandusky River region of northwestern Ohio Bowes uses the 1833 Treaty of Chicago as a lens through which to examine the forces that drove the divergent removals of various Potawatomi communities from northern Illinois and Indiana

And in exploring the experiences of the Odawas and Ojibwes in Michigan Territory he analyzes the historical context and choices that enabled some Indian communities to avoid relocation west of the Mississippi River In expanding the context of removal to include the Old Northwest and adding a portrait of Native communities there before during and after removal Bowes paints a more accurate and complicated picture of American Indian history in the nineteenth century Land Too Good for Indians reveals the deeper complexities of this crucial time in American history *AHA Perspectives*, 2000 **America, History and Life**, 1996 Article abstracts and citations of reviews and dissertations covering the United States and Canada
