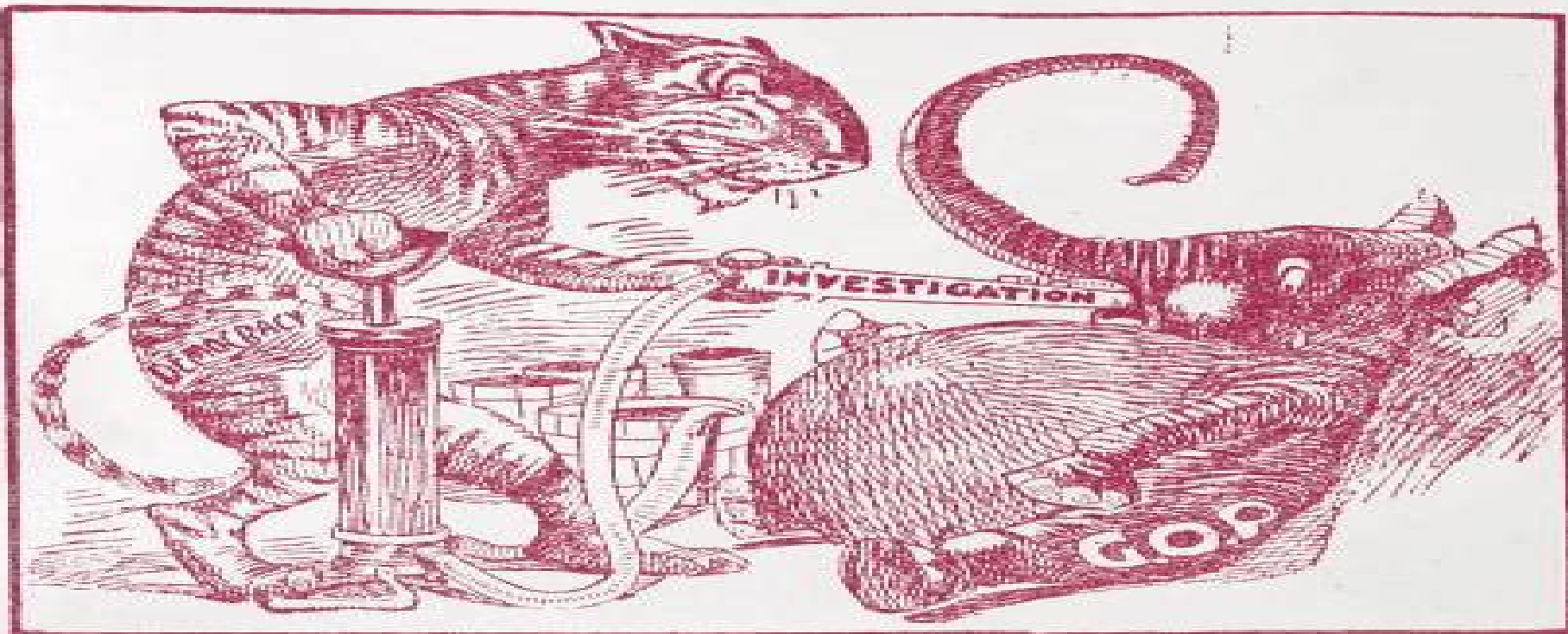
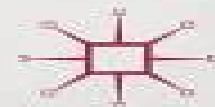

Einolf uses the historical debate to illuminate theories of present day human rights advocacy. The conclusion relates the Philippine War case to the more recent use of torture under the George W Bush administration and makes recommendations for researchers and advocates.
