Vocabulary: absorption spectrum, binary star, blueshift, Cepheid variable, emission spectrum, giant star, nebula, redshift, spectrum, star

Prior Knowledge Questions (Do these BEFORE using the Gizmo.)

1. What happens when light goes through a prism? It is bent, or refracted, by the angles and plane faces of the prism and each wavelength of light is refracted by a slightly different amount.

This band of colors is called a **spectrum**.

2. A rainbow is an example of a spectrum. What is the sequence of colors in a rainbow?

Red, orange, yellow, blue, indigo, violet

The interior of a **star** produces a continuous spectrum of light, like a rainbow. Cooler gases in the outer layers of the star absorb certain wavelengths of light, causing dark lines to appear in the spectrum. The resulting **absorption spectrum** can tell astronomers a great deal about the star.

1. On the *Star Spectra* Gizmo, turn on **Show labels**. Select **star 1** to see its absorption spectrum.

How many lines do you see in the spectrum? five



2. Drag the **Hydrogen** spectrum next to the **Star spectrum** so that the edges line up. Do some of the lines on the two spectra match up? Yes four lines on the spectrum do line up
3. Drag the **Helium** spectrum next to the **Star spectrum**. Do some lines match? Yes some do match
4. Try out the other available spectra. Do any others have lines that match? No
5. Which elements have contributed to the spectrum of **star 1**? Hydrogen and helium

Note: The elements in a star's spectrum do not necessarily reflect what the star is made of. The absorption spectrum is mostly determined by the surface temperature of the star.
