Describe the function of the vacuole - answer Stores water and chemicals for cell use. Also maintains turgor of cell

Describe the function of the tonoplasts - answer Membrane the surrounds the vacuole. Protects the vacuole, isolates it from harmful substances and controls water flow in and out of the vacuole
