Mahatma Gandhi started salt march accompanied by 78 of his trusted volunteers. On 6 April he reached Dandi, and ceremonially violated the law manufacturing salt by boiling sea water.

The Idea of Satyagraha

in 1916 he travelled to Champaran in Bihar to inspire the peasants to struggle against the oppressive plantation system. Then in 1917, he organised a satyagraha to support the peasants of the Khada district of Gujarat.

The Rowlatt Act

Gondhiji in 1919 decided to brunch a nationwede satyagraha against the proposed Rowlast Act (1919).

On 13th April the Infamous jallianwalla Bagh Incident sook place. At the Calcutta session of the Congress in September 1920, he committeed other leaders of the meed to start a mon-cooperation movement in support of Khilafat as well as for swara.

Why Non-cooperation?

Gandhiji believed, if Indians refused to cooperate, British rule in India would collapse within a year, and twaraj would come. At the Congress session at Nagpur in December 1920, a compromise was worked out and the Non-cooperation programme was adopted.
