1. Simplify: $\frac{\tan \theta}{\sec \theta} = \frac{\sin \theta}{\cos \theta} \div \frac{1}{\cos \theta} = \frac{\sin \theta}{\cos \theta} \cdot \frac{\cos \theta}{1} = \boxed{\sin \theta}$

2. Simplify: $\frac{1}{1-\sin u} + \frac{1}{1+\sin u}$ *Hint: LCD

$$\frac{1+\sin u}{(1-\sin u)(1+\sin u)} + \frac{1-\sin u}{(1-\sin u)(1+\sin u)} = \frac{2}{1-\sin^2 u} = \frac{2}{\cos^2 u} = \boxed{2 \sec^2 u}$$

3. Simplify: $\frac{1-\cos^2 v}{\sin v + \cos v \sin v}$ *Hint: Factor!

$$\frac{(1+\cancel{\cos v})(1-\cos v)}{\sin v (1+\cancel{\cos v})} = \frac{1-\cos v}{\sin v} = \frac{1}{\sin v} - \frac{\cos v}{\sin v} = \boxed{\csc v - \cot v}$$

EXAMPLES: Simplify the following:

1. $\frac{\cot \theta}{\csc \theta} = \frac{\cos \theta}{\sin \theta} \div \frac{1}{\sin \theta}$

$$\frac{\cos \theta}{\sin \theta} \cdot \frac{\sin \theta}{1} = \boxed{\cos \theta}$$

2. $\frac{1+\cos \theta}{\cos \theta} = \frac{1}{\cos \theta} + \frac{\cos \theta}{\cos \theta} = \boxed{\sec \theta + 1}$

3. $\frac{\sin^2 \theta - 1}{\tan \theta \sin \theta - \tan \theta} = \frac{(\sin \theta + 1)(\cancel{\sin \theta} - 1)}{\tan \theta (\cancel{\sin \theta} - 1)} = \frac{\sin \theta + 1}{\tan \theta}$

$$= \frac{\sin \theta}{\tan \theta} + \frac{1}{\tan \theta} = \frac{\sin \theta}{\frac{\sin \theta}{\cos \theta}} + \cot \theta = \frac{\sin \theta \cos \theta}{\sin \theta} + \cot \theta = \boxed{\cos \theta + \cot \theta}^1$$
