analysis helps identify areas for improvement in profitability and efficiency Cash Flow Analysis Cash flow analysis involves examining the company s cash flows from operating investing and financing activities to assess its ability to generate cash invest in growth opportunities and meet financial obligations Comparative Analysis Comparative analysis involves comparing the company s financial performance and position with its peers industry benchmarks or competitors.
