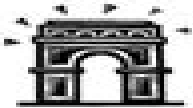
B. Physical characteristics (the land):

C. Human characteristics (the people) :

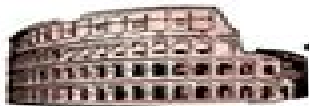
- master road builders (*economic specialization*),
