Phenomenology of Anxiety Stefano Micali, 2022-03-30 This volume offers a thorough description of anxiety from a phenomenological perspective Building on Bakhtin's insights the author develops the method of phenomenological polyphony which can do justice to the essential ambiguity of anxiety In this polyphony the voices of Kierkegaard Husserl Freud Blumenberg Heidegger Sartre Adorno Derrida and Levinas are particularly recognizable The book explores new perspectives on the complex relation between anxiety fear and trauma with reference to different disciplines from art history to cultural anthropology from psychopathology to theology from literature to political philosophy When is anxiety justified When does anxiety cease to function as an effective and reasonable signal preventing imminent threats and when does it become an invasive projection of our own ghosts This volume presents a deep philosophical inquiry into the affective phenomenon that can both protect us from danger and be a danger in itself Moreover the author explores the relevance of anxiety in the context of philosophical anthropology In various theoretical frameworks the difference between anxiety and fear serves as a criterion for distinguishing human beings from animals in particular Accordingly research on anxiety is crucial for defining human nature as such The analysis presented in this volume shows how an alteration of the dimensions of embodiment time consciousness and phantasy takes place in anxiety Furthermore the author elaborates on new categories for understanding of anxiety such as quasi intentional imaginative anticipation which eludes the traditional differentiation between perception and imagination The work culminates in a phenomenological analysis of five essential traits of anxiety 1 its quasi intentional imaginative anticipation 2 its negative inspiration 3 the recurrence of bodily manifestations 4 the interlocution with an alien power 5 its negative teleology

City Status in the British Isles, 1830-2002 John Beckett, 2017-07-05 Based on a wide variety of government and civic records this book traces the evolution of the changing nature of city status particularly through the nineteenth and twentieth centuries Beginning with an explanation of how city status first became connected to cathedrals in the medieval period the book explores how during the nineteenth century links evolved between Anglican diocesan sub divisions and city creation It then shows how in a few years between 1888 and 1907 the traditional interpretation of a city was overturned as the most major British industrial and commercial towns received city status and lord mayoralties The second half of the book concentrates on city status during the twentieth century and particularly the politicisation of the process and the linking of grants to royal occasions The study concludes by looking at the city status competitions of 2000 and 2002 in relation to the previous two hundred years of city history

National Library of Medicine Catalog National Library of Medicine (U.S.), 1966 *New York 1927* Alexander Alekhine, 2011-03-21 Alekhine's Controversial Masterpiece Finally in English For decades Alexander Alekhine's account of New York 1927 was at the top of the list of works that should have been rendered into English but unaccountably were not This is unlike any other tournament book ever written Not only do you have one of the greatest annotators of all time rendering some brilliant analysis but he melds it with an exceptional agenda an anti Capablanca agenda And since he wrote it after defeating Capablanca in their marathon match he sounds like a sore loser who became a sore winner So this is just a mean spirited book right Nothing of the sort Alekhine goes beyond elaborate move analysis and offers deep positional insights and psychological observations Nikolai Grigoriev in his foreword to the 1930 Russian edition of this book pointed out how Alekhine broke new ground by underlining the critical moments of each game Why Alekhine's work was published in German in Berlin in 1928 and not in English is unclear But now after more than 80 years it's finally available to the largest audience of chessplayers It's about time

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
