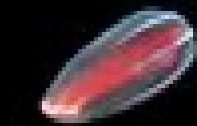

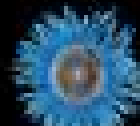
**Platyhelminthes**  
A flatworm, likely a planarian, showing its internal organs and lateral eyes.



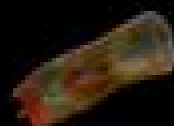
**Nematodes**

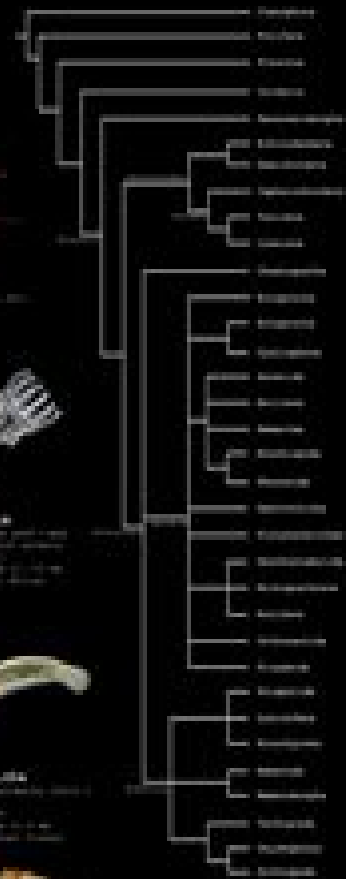

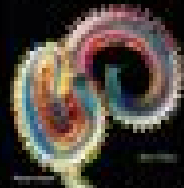
