Jill Khadduri, Dennis Culhane, 2011 The AHAR provides the results of local counts of people homeless on a single night in January as well as estimates of the number characteristics and service patterns of all people who used residential programs for homeless people during the 2010 federal Fiscal Year Oct 2009 Sept 2010 Also for the first time this year s AHAR includes info about the use of permanent supportive housing programs and the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re Housing Program This is the first report to provide national estimates on the use of the full continuum of homeless assistance programs from homelessness prevention to homeless residential services to permanent supportive housing Charts and tables This is a print on demand report *2009 Annual Homeless Assessment* Alvaro Cortes, 2011 This is a print on demand edition of a hard to find publication Provides year to year trend information that explores changes in the patterns of homelessness over time This year s Annual Assessment Report AHAR is delivered at a critical moment as the Federal government continues to shift its focus toward preventing homelessness and on the eve of the first ever federal plan to end homelessness The 2009 AHAR captures a large portion of the economic crisis in its reporting period It provides real evidence that the economic downturn is impacting the housing stability of low income and vulnerable Americans as we see a rise in family homelessness for the second consecutive year This year s report allows for a comparative analysis of homelessness that spans three years 2007 2008 and 2009 *2008 Annual Homelessness Assessment* , 2010-10 Provides year to year trend info that explores changes in the patterns of homelessness over time Focuses on two types of national estimates of homelessness Point in time estimates provide the total number of sheltered and un sheltered homeless persons on a single night in January Also provides one year estimates of the total sheltered population The one year estimates account for persons who used a homeless residential program at any time during a 12 month period The report compares one year estimates for 2007 and 2008 This report comes at a time of economic uncertainty and provides a few early indicators of how the economic downturn may be affecting the housing situation of low income and vulnerable Americans Illus **The Third Annual Homeless Assessment Report to Congress** U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, 2010 The U S Department of Housing and Urban Development HUD is pleased to present to Congress the 2007 Annual Homeless Assessment Report AHAR This is the third report in a series of reports on homelessness in the United States and the first to be based on a full year of Homeless Management Information Systems HMIS data reported by communities across the country This 2007 report will provide a baseline for measuring changes in homelessness from one year to the next The reports respond to a series of Congressional directives beginning with the FY 2001 HUD Appropriations Act In that year Congress directed HUD to assist communities in implementing local HMIS and required every jurisdiction to begin client level reporting within three years Senate Report 106 410 noted that HMIS data could be used to develop an unduplicated count of homeless people and to analyze the use and effectiveness of

homelessness assistance services To that end Congress further charged HUD with collecting and analyzing HMIS data from a representative sample of communities in order to understand the nature and extent of homelessness across the nation

Empowerment as Ceremony William Epstein, 2017-07-28 Many people in the United States are poor lead marginal lives and need jobs as well as basic services such as education medical care and housing Multitudes in other parts of the world in addition to being poor are jailed tortured and killed for being members of the wrong ethnic group or expressing political opinions Those who argue for empowerment claim it is a magic bullet It can liberate the oppressed largely through self organization self motivation self invention and even self clarity William M Epstein sees contemporary empowerment practice in the United States as a civic church of national values one better in performing its ceremonial role than god based houses of worship By itself empowerment is not worth the effort of commentary since it achieves none of its goals and has not even generated a respectable critical literature But Epstein argues that empowerment practice and American social welfare both embody prescriptive cultural preferences Like art and music empowerment opens windows into deeper social meaning The social sciences have carved out roles for themselves by looking for simple remedies ones that are inexpensive and compatible with contemporary social arrangements Epstein shows that those in social work practices have not only deluded themselves into thinking that these services have real instrumental

value but really operate at cross purposes This accessible work will attract critical attention among these professional groups It bases its carefully documented insights upon informed sociological and anthropological theory
