There are 13 kangaroos bouncing in the grass when 7 more come to join the fun. How many are there now?



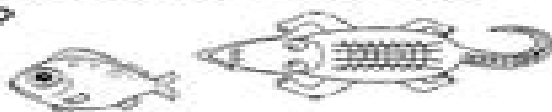
8 lizards are on a rock and then 9 more appear. How many are there now?
