

American History (in brief)

Early America

Goal: Find Northwest Passage (easier trade route from Europe to Asia)

Four European nations mainly settled and explored America (in order of their arrival)

SPAIN

- Sent Columbus in 1492 (was looking for Asia, but got lost)
- Majority of colonies in South America (where they copied the Inca and Aztec Empire)
- Settled in Florida (St. Augustine) and New Mexico (Santa Fe) and California (San Diego)
- Enslaved, converted, and killed most of the natives.

FRANCE

- Sent Jacques Cartier who claimed Canada and founded Quebec in 1535
- Most colonies in Canada, trading posts in Mississippi and Great Lakes area which they explored.
- Traded with native Americans for furs, so they married and lived with them, didn't convert them.

NORTHERLANDS (Dutch)

- Sent Henry Hudson to explore New York area (Hudson River)
- Set up trading post for furs on Manhattan.
- Founded New York (renamed by the English) and Albany
- Had good relations with natives for the most part.

ENGLISH

- Sent John Cabot to claim North America in 1497
- Settled in Virginia (Jamestown in 1607) and New England (Plymouth in 1609)
- Had good relations with Natives in beginning, but desire for more land turned to war.
- Eventually founded 13 colonies along Atlantic (which would become first 13 states)

Why the English came to New World

- Religious Freedom (Puritans to New England, Catholics to Maryland, Quakers to Pennsylvania)
- Make money (out of cheap land, tobacco and other cash crops, slavery to rise to class system)

American Revolution

Causes

French and Indian War: War between French and English. (Washington becomes well known during it)

- Hated by England (needed taxes) so they tax the colonies
- Colonists don't want to pay taxes without representation in parliament

Big Moments (leading up to the war)

- Stamp Act: Taxes all printed materials (books, legal documents)
- Boston Massacre: 5 colonists shot by British soldiers, used as propaganda
- Boston Tea Party: Protest over taxes that results in Boston being occupied by army
- Battles of Lexington and Concord: First shots of the war

Following first shots, all colonies meet in Philadelphia at Second Continental Congress

- Try to pursue peace (Olive Branch Petition) but eventually decide to declare independence
- Declaration of Independence: Written by Thomas Jefferson. Break-up Letter with Britain.
