2. Declaration and American Independence (1763-1776) Main Facts to Remember

- 1763 marked the end of the French and Indian War a war where the Americans and British fought against the French and Indians; the Americans and British won, but the war had a negative effect on their relationship (see next bullet point).
- After 1763 the British <u>abandoned their policy of salutary neglect</u> because they felt that
 they had spent a lot of money on the French and Indian War and that the Americans should
 pay the cost; for this reason, the British put lots of <u>new taxes</u> on the Americans for
 example, the **Stamp Act**, the **Sugar Act**, and the **Tea Act**.
- The American colonists thought the new British taxes were <u>unfair</u> because they had <u>no one</u> to represent them in the British government ("No taxation without representation!").
- Eventually, the American colonists became so unhappy with the British taxes that they
 began to protest some examples: the <u>Stamp Act Congress</u>, <u>boycotts of British products</u>,
 the <u>Sons of Liberty</u>, the <u>Boston Tea Party</u>, the <u>First Continental Congress</u>, the <u>Second</u>
 Continental Congress.
- The Second Continental Congress decided that America should break away from England and become an independent country; they assigned Thomas Jefferson the job of writing a document that described the reasons for American independence – this document was called the **Declaration of Independence**.
- The main ideas contained in the Declaration of Independence are:
 - "All men are created equal" every human being has natural rights rights that
 they are born with and which are "unalienable," meaning they can't be taken
 away ("life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness"); this idea comes from John Locke
 and the European Enlightenment.
 - Another Enlightenment idea contained in the Declaration is social contract it says that people owe loyalty only to a government that acts in their best interests.
 - The Declaration says that the main job of the government is to protect people's
 natural rights; if the government fails to do this, then the people have the right to
 "alter or abolish" (change or get rid of) that government and create a new one.
 - Lastly, the Declaration of Independence argues that the government gets its power from "the consent of the governed." In other words, the government gets its power from the people; they must give their "consent" (permission) to be governed.
