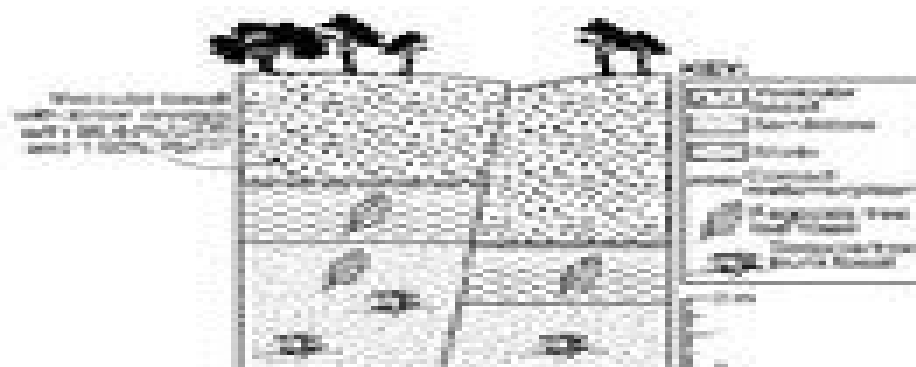

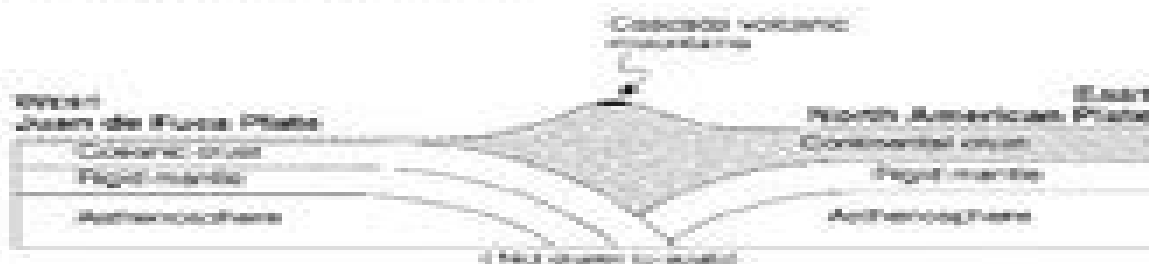
The geologic cross section below represents an outcrop of various types of bedrock and bedrock features in Colorado.
