$$x + y = 7$$

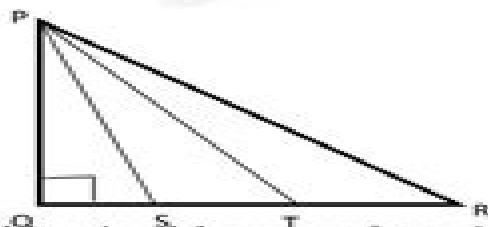
$$5x + 2y = 20$$
