4. cartilaginous joints	cartilage wedged between bones: no joint cavity, example are symphysis, functional classification is amphiarthrosis
5. Synchondroses	type one of cartilaginous joints, bones joined by hyaline cartilage
6. Synovial Joints	end of bone covered w articular cartilage: joint cavity w synovial fluid, example is elbow joint and functional classification is Diarthrosis
