Right and Left Lungs

Our respiratory system is the main part which air enters the body. The right (anterior) side, the left (posterior) side.

The main cavity is made up of two parts - the right and left lung cavities.

Right lung - the right lung is larger and contains the right ventricle of the heart.

Left lung - the left lung is smaller and contains the left ventricle of the heart.

Diaphragm - the diaphragm is a muscular partition between the chest and abdominal cavities.

Trachea - the trachea is the windpipe, which carries air from the lungs to the rest of the body.

Bronchi - the bronchi are the main airways that branch out from the trachea into the lungs.

Alveoli - the alveoli are the tiny air sacs where gas exchange takes place.

Capillaries - the capillaries are the tiny blood vessels that surround the alveoli.

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The Bronchial

Right and Left Lungs

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inflation and deflation of the lungs depends on the regular contractions of the diaphragm and the external intercostal muscles. This is dependent on the contraction and relaxation of the muscles of respiration and the elastic connective tissue.

Mechanism of Respiration

During normal quiet breathing the diaphragm contracts and

the external intercostal muscles contract.

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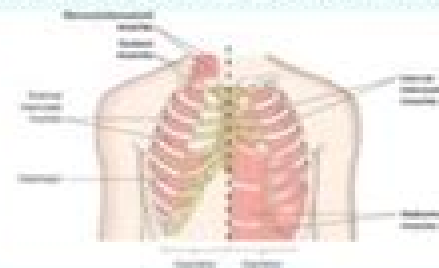
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Respiratory Muscles

- External intercostal muscles (in pairs)
- Diaphragm
- Abdominal muscles (in pairs)
- Internal intercostal muscles (in pairs)

Respiratory System

- Trachea, bronchi (20-25 "in" and "out" air)
- Alveoli, internal intercostal muscles, 10-15

Inhalation - The muscles of respiration contract and volume starts to rise, this is an **expansion** process as it starts moving. Inhalation last approximately **2 seconds**.

Contraction of the **external intercostal muscles** pulls the rib cage upwards and outwards.

The **diaphragm** contracts when contracted, increasing the thoracic cavity.

As the diaphragm contracts, the pressure inside decreases, resulting in **negative pressure**, since the negative pressure is below atmospheric pressure, air is drawn in.

Exhalation - **Relaxation** process, doesn't use energy.

Relaxation of the external intercostal muscles allows the rib cage to move down and in and the **relaxation of the diaphragm** reduces the size of the thoracic cavity.

As the diaphragm relaxes the pressure in the cavity increases, resulting in **positive pressure**, since it increases more than atmospheric pressure, air is forced out.



Factors affecting respiration

Temperature - rate of elasticity of the connective tissues in the lungs will increase with temperature.

Compliance - measure of the distensibility. High compliance, lung will expand easily. Low compliance, lung will not expand to volume.

Respiratory rate

Lung Volume

Residual lung volume - the volume of air that stays in the air passages but isn't inhaled or exhaled.

Tidal volume - the amount of air that goes in and out of the lungs during normal breathing.

Inspiratory reserve volume - the extra amount of air that can be inhaled into the lungs during maximal inspiration.

Expiratory reserve volume - the maximum amount of air that can be exhaled, tidal volume + inspiratory reserve volume.

Functional residual volume - the amount of air remaining in the air passages and alveoli at the end of normal expiration.

Respiratory reserve volume - the largest amount of air that can be expired during maximal expiration.

Residual volume - amount of air left in the lungs after forced expiration.

Total capacity - maximum volume of air which can be moved in and out of the lungs.

Respiratory Process

Inhalation - normal, unforced breathing.

Exhalation - no breathing.

Hyperinflation - An abnormally rapid breathing rate of more than 10 breaths per minute.

Hyperventilation - An abnormally slow rate of breathing.

Composition of Inspired and Expired Air

Water	Variable	Saturated

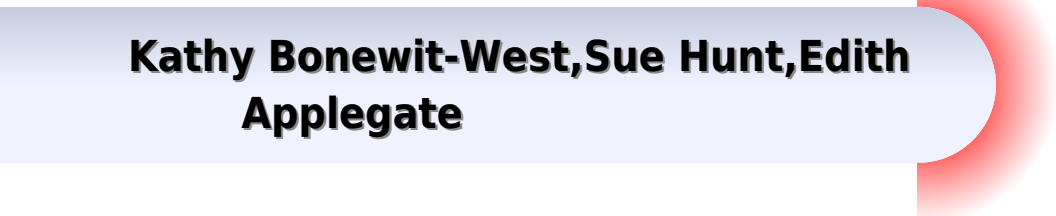
