 There are 2 types of worms: worms that eat at night (nocturnal) and worms that eat during the day (diurnal). The birds eat during the day and seem to be eating ONLY the diurnal worms. The nocturnal worms are in their burrows during this time. Each spring when the worms reproduce, they have about 500 babies but only 100 of

these 500 ever become old enough to reproduce.

Population has variations. There are 2 types of worms in the area (diurnal and nocturnal)

Some variations are favorable. <u>Birds do not eat noctumal worms (noctumal worms advantage)</u>

More offspring are produced than survive. 100 of the original 500 worms survive to reproduce

Those that survive have favorable traits. More nocturnal worms survive and reproduce

A population will change over time. Nocturnal worm population increases: diurnal worm population decreases
