Authentic Garum Recipe Hans Gimse, 2021-06-30 In ancient times garum the fermented fish sauce was made from the entrails of fresh fish placed in vats and layered with salt and sometimes herbs then pressed with a stone to extract the essence It was used as a seasoning to add salinity and umami to dishes and was so concentrated that only a few drops were needed Commonly garum was diluted in olive oil wine and vinegar to make sauces or diluted with water for drinking This book presents a selection of historical recipes from Ancient Mesopotamia Ancient Rome the European and Middle Eastern Middle Ages and the Renaissance that are adapted to contemporary cooking and can be reproduced in a normal household kitchen with available ingredients
