lifted He survived the war but then had to fight its emotional effects He began reading the Bible and searching for God's will for his life He also fought the Veterans Administration for benefits to help him with the physical effects of his war wounds He fought through pain each day in order to get out of bed to go to work to provide for his family He fought the paralysis that finally overtook his body Even as a paraplegic he continued to participate in the community He greeted and offered friendly smiles to those he met He fought the good fight
