The Impossible Dream Jasper Fullard, MD, 2022-09-07 Racism and healthcare disparities have always been a problem in the Black community especially small country towns This book illustrates how a poor Black boy at the age of twelve watched his mother almost die from the lack of adequate health care from a White doctor I come from a very poor family of eleven children poor education environment low self esteem and with no Black professionals except for Black teachers to inspire me and other Blacks in the community but at the age of twelve I promised my mother that one day I would become a doctor so that Blacks would not have to suffer from the lack of adequate health care The promise to my mother was an impossible dream By reading this book you will learn how the miracles of God navigated my crooked journey and how the impossible was made possible and I was able to obtain a bachelor of science master of science two years on a PhD program before completing a medical degree Along with other health care providers I was able to organize a not for profit organization to decrease healthcare disparities in the Black community

A Shaw grew up in a segregated African American neighborhood in St Louis His tight knit community supported him and he was inspired to become first a teacher and then a lawyer From there he worked his way up to federal prosecutor and state judge before President Bill Clinton appointed him to the federal bench Shaw quickly became dismayed by the inequality and severity of mandatory U S sentencing guidelines and how they affected young African American men Prosecutors opposed him at every turn as he sought to impose fair sentences but he never wavered in seeking to promote equality and curb the destruction of African American families This insightful and at times humorous narrative demonstrates Shaw s love for family hard work and God Including an insider s view of an often unjust legal system tales of working alongside some of the best legal minds in the country and challenges to prevailing concepts *Watch Everything* offers a rare glimpse into the professional life of an unconventional federal judge

Signs of Grace Kristin Schwain, 2008 Religious imagery was ubiquitous in late nineteenth century American life department stores schoolbooks postcards and popular magazines all featured elements of Christian visual culture Such imagery was not limited to commercial and religious artifacts however for it also found its way into contemporary fine art In *Signs of Grace* Kristin Schwain looks anew at the explicitly religious work of four prominent artists in this period Thomas Eakins F Holland Day Abbott Handerson Thayer and Henry Ossawa Tanner and argues that art and religion performed analogous functions within American culture Fully expressing the concerns and values of turn of the century Americans this artwork depicted religious figures and encouraged the beholders communion with them Describing how these artists drew on their religious beliefs and practices as well as how beholders looked to art to provide a transcendent experience Schwain explores how a modern conception of faith as an individual relationship with the divine facilitated this sanctified relationship between art and viewer This stress on the interior and subjective experience of religion accentuated the artist s efforts to engage beholders personally with works of art how better to fix the viewer s attention than to hold out the promise of salvation Schwain shows that while these new visual practices emphasized individual encounters with art objects they also carried profound social implications By negotiating changes in religious belief by aestheticizing faith in a new particularly American manner these practices contributed to evolving debates about art ethnicity sexuality and gender
