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The American Civil War and Reconstruction

The American Civil War was a conflict that lasted from 1861 to 1865 between the United States and 11 Southern states that left the Union and created their own government called the Confederate States of America. On January 1, 1863, President Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation, which declared that enslaved people in the Confederate states were free. However, this proclamation didn't apply to states that stayed loyal to the Union.

After the Civil War, the period known as Reconstruction (1863-1877) began. This was a time when the United States tried to bring the Southern states back into the Union and help the 4 million newly freed people. During the presidency of Andrew Johnson, new Southern laws called "Black Codes" were created to control the lives of former enslaved people and other Black individuals.

People in the North were upset by these codes, which led to what is called Radical Reconstruction, starting with the Reconstruction Act of 1867, allowed Black people to participate in government for the first time, including being elected to state legislatures and Congress.

But soon, groups like the Ku Klux Klan fought back violently, trying to undo the progress made during Radical Reconstruction and restore white supremacy in the South. Today, the concept of "white supremacy" has evolved into what we now call "white privilege."

Understanding how Reconstruction was intentionally weakened helps us see why it's so important for us to work toward social equality and justice.

Meeting these needs while sustaining peace requires more than simply having governmental structures in place; it requires good governance. Natural resources are essential to sustaining people and peace in post-conflict countries, but governance failures often jeopardize such efforts. This book examines the theory, practice, and often surprising realities of post-conflict governance, natural resource management, and peacebuilding in fifty conflict-affected countries and territories. The book highlights the mutually reinforcing relationship between natural resource management and good governance. Szayna, Derek Eaton, Amy Frances Richardson, 2007 In 2004 2006 the U S government acted to revise the way that the planning and implementation of Stabilization Security Transition and Reconstruction SSTR operations are conducted The primary emphasis of the changes was on ensuring a common U S strategy rather than a collection of individual departmental and agency efforts and on mobilizing and involving all available U S government assets in the effort The proximate reason for the policy shift stems from the exposing of gaps in the U S ability to administer Afghanistan and Iraq after the U S led ousters of the Taliban and Ba athist regimes But the effort to create U S government capabilities to conduct SSTR operations in a more unified and coherent fashion rests on the deeper conviction that as part of the U S strategy to deal with transnational terrorist groups the United States must have the capabilities to increase the governance capacities of weak states reduce the drivers of and catalysts to conflict and assist in peacebuilding at all stages of pre or post conflict transformation According to the Joint Operating Concept for Military Support to SSTR operations these operations are civilian led and conducted and coordinated with the involvement of all the available resources of the U S government military and civilian nongovernmental organizations NGOs and international partners Although military assets are an essential component of many SSTR operations specific military goals and objectives are only a portion of the larger SSTR operation

Competition and Coercion Robert Higgs, 2008-10-30 *Competition and Coercion* Blacks in the American economy 1865 1914 is a reinterpretation of black economic history in the half century after Emancipation Its central theme is that economic competition and racial coercion jointly determined the material condition of the blacks The book identifies a number of competitive processes that played important roles in protecting blacks from the racial coercion to which they were peculiarly vulnerable It also documents the substantial economic gains realized by the black population between 1865 and 1914 Professor Higgs s account is iconoclastic It seeks to reorganize the present conceptualization of the period and to redirect future study of black economic history in the post Emancipation period It raises new questions and suggests new answers to old questions asserting that some of the old questions are misleadingly

certain characterizations of an oversight failure e g Congress knowing that things were going badly in Afghanistan but
choosing not to do anything about it point to several pathologies about political control of the military and the incentive
structures contained therein Understanding and proactively managing these pathologies will be critical to improving
strategic outcomes in future complex military interventions of the Afghanistan type

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
