1. English, Colonial, customs and administrative from British lawmakers are important contributions to the founding principles and development of the United States.

2. The principle that a government system should absolutely derive from the Magna Carta, which the English people have long regarded as a guarantee of English, government.

3. The English Bill of Rights and other documents that increasingly and ultimately established the concept applied to them and gave them the same rights as people living in Britain.

4. The English system of law, especially as organized by the British Parliament, was widely followed in the colonies.

5. British Parliament, with delegates representing the people, was a familiar example of representative, government, but they criticized it.

7. John Locke believed that people have natural, rights, as human beings and a government that failed to protect them has lost its legitimacy.

8. John Locke believed that men, women, children, believed that basic rights and responsibilities beyond any people in a community were automatically accepted as natural without the presence of rights which involving law and government.

9. Charles-Louis de Montesquieu suggested separation, the powers of government.
