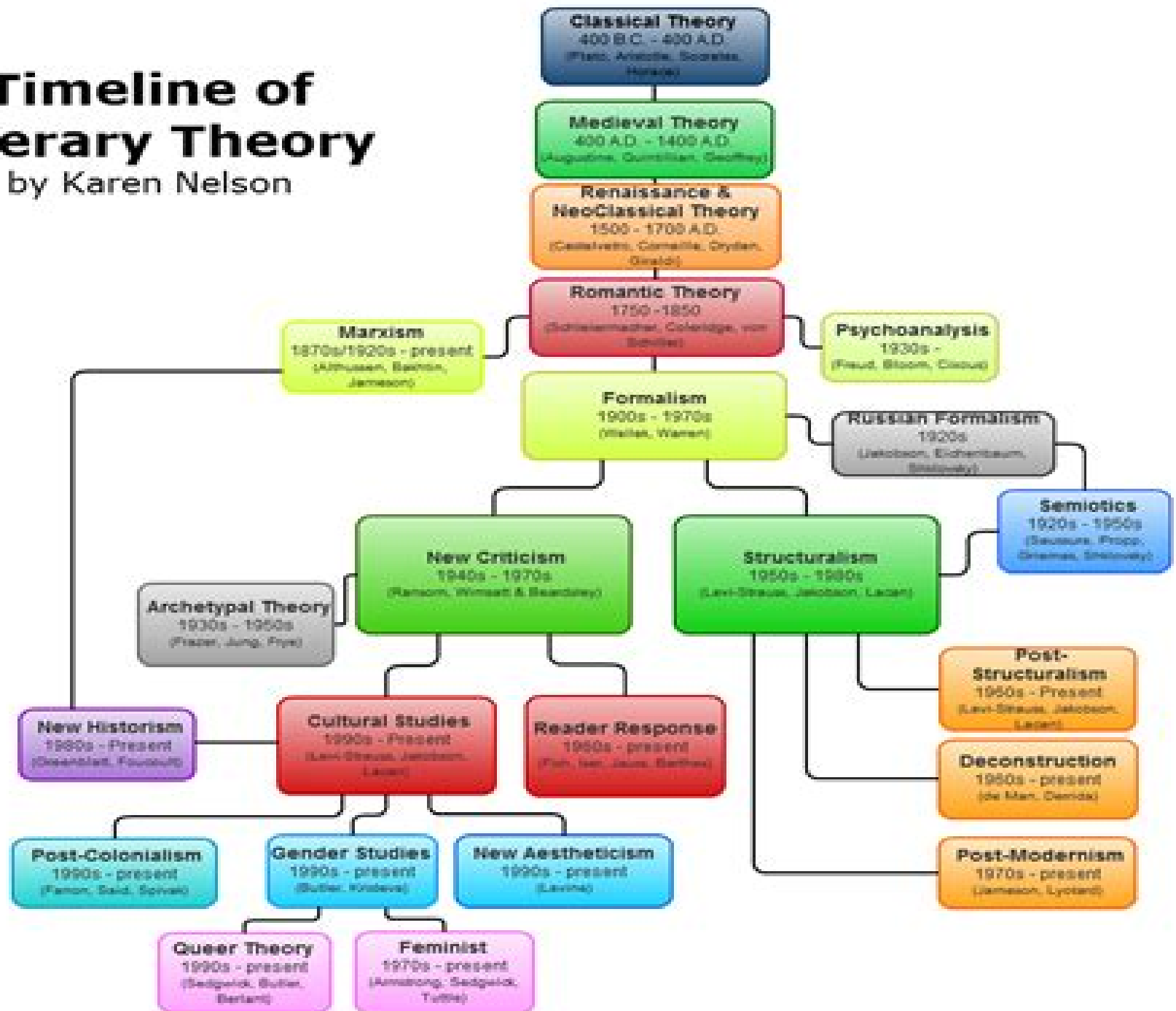

The three texts are R In the Cage by Henry James, St Mawr by D H Lawrence and Heart of Darkness by Joseph Conrad. The branches of theory applied to them are Structuralism, Narrative Theory and Character Theory, Psychoanalytic Theory, Feminism, Linguistics and Reader Response Theory, Deconstruction and Marxism.
