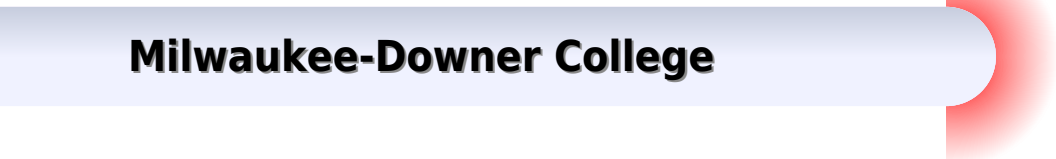

Herget, 2009-12-24 This book evolved from a one year sequence of courses offered by the authors at Iowa State University The audience for this book typically included theoretically oriented first or second year graduate students in various engineering or science disciplines
