

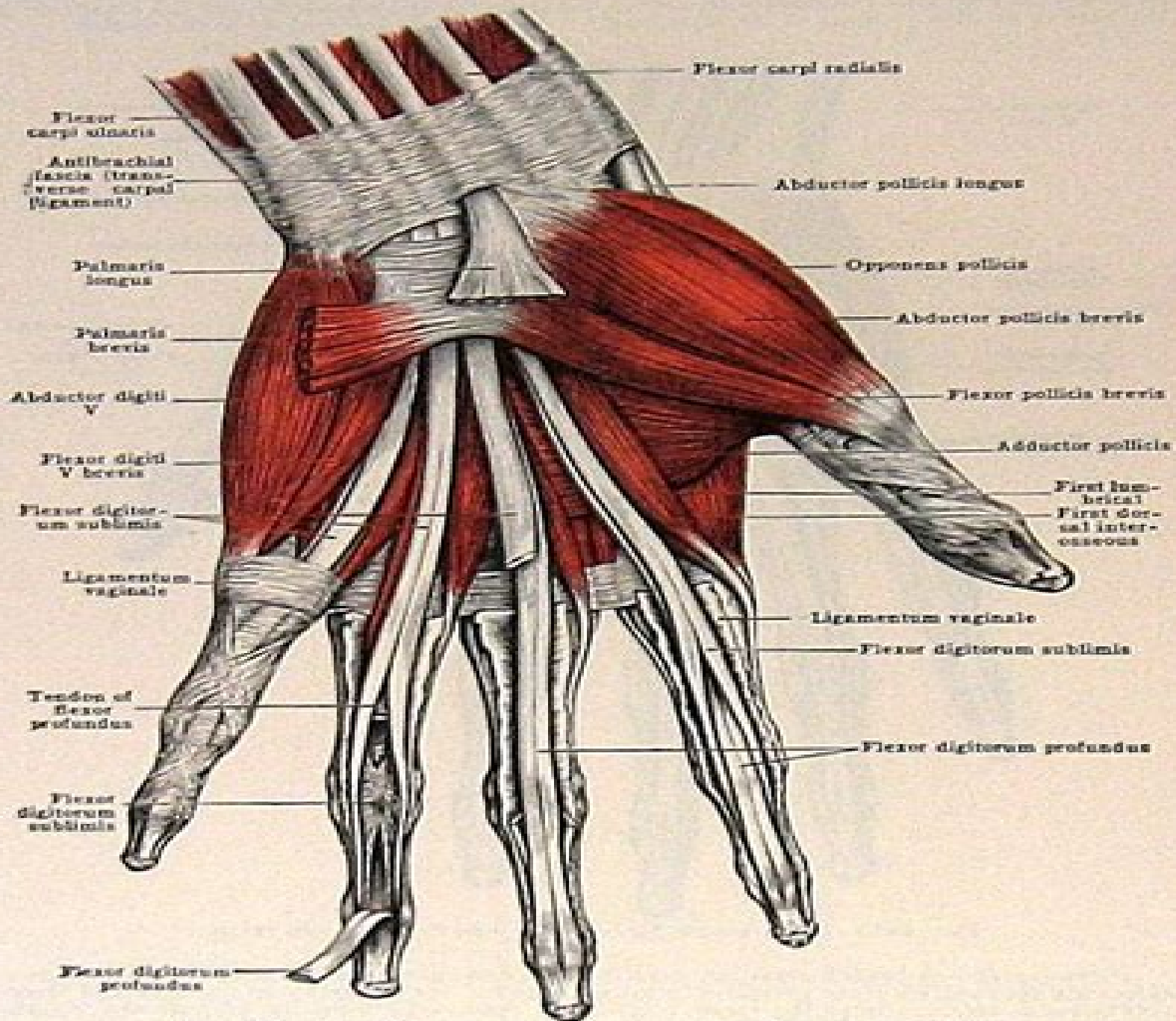


FIG. 439.—THE SUPERFICIAL MUSCLES OF THE PALM OF THE HAND.
