Digestive	Mouth	Chew food and swallow it.
	Esophagus	Carry food down to the stomach.
	Stomach	Break down food into smaller pieces.
	Intestines	Absorb nutrients from food.

Excretory	Kidneys	Filter waste from the blood.
	Ureters	Carry urine from the kidneys to the bladder.
	Bladder	Store urine.
	Urethra	Carry urine out of the body.
Reproductive	Ovaries	Produce eggs.
	Uterus	Where the fetus develops.
	Vagina	Carry the fetus out of the body.
	Testes	Produce sperm.

Endocrine	Hypothalamus	Controls the body's internal clock.
	Pituitary gland	Controls the body's growth and development.
	Thyroid gland	Controls the body's metabolism.
	Adrenal glands	Produce hormones that control the body's response to stress.

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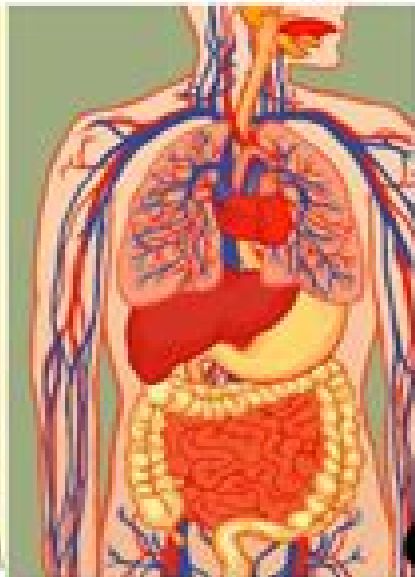
