Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology

Definition: The study of the structure and function of the human body.

Branches:

- Anatomy:** The study of the structure of the body.
- Physiology:** The study of the function of the body.

Levels of Organization:

- Chemical
- Cellular

- Organism

Cell Structure

Cell: The basic unit of life.

Prokaryotic Cell: A cell that lacks a nucleus and other membrane-bound organelles.

Eukaryotic Cell: A cell that has a nucleus and other membrane-bound organelles.

Organelles: Specialized structures within a cell that perform specific functions.

Examples: Mitochondrion, Golgi apparatus, Lysosome, Endoplasmic reticulum.

Connective Tissues

Definition: Tissues that bind other tissues together.

Types:

- Epithelial Tissue:** Covers the body and organs.
- Muscle Tissue:** Contracts to produce movement.
- Nervous Tissue:** Transmits electrical impulses.
- Connective Tissue:** Supports and connects other tissues.

Muscle Tissues

Definition: Tissues that contract to produce movement.

Types:

- Skeletal Muscle:** Voluntary, striated muscle.
- Cardiac Muscle:** Involuntary, striated muscle.
- Smooth Muscle:** Involuntary, non-striated muscle.

Nervous Tissues

Definition: Tissues that transmit electrical impulses.

Types:

- Neuron:** The basic unit of the nervous system.
- Glia:** Support cells for neurons.

Integumentary System

Definition: The system that covers the body and protects it from the environment.

Components: Skin, hair, nails, and glands.

Functions: Protection, regulation of body temperature, and sensation.

Respiratory System

Definition: The system that takes in oxygen and removes carbon dioxide.

Components: Lungs, trachea, bronchi, and bronchioles.

Functions: Gas exchange and regulation of blood pH.

Circulatory System

Definition: The system that transports blood throughout the body.

Components: Heart, arteries, veins, and capillaries.

Functions: Transport of oxygen, nutrients, and waste products.

Endocrine System

Definition: The system that regulates the body's metabolism and growth.

Components: Pituitary gland, thyroid gland, adrenal gland, and others.

Functions: Regulation of body temperature, metabolism, and growth.

Reproductive System

Definition: The system that produces and transports gametes.

Components: Ovaries, uterus, fallopian tubes, and others.

Functions: Production of offspring.
