1. What is Old Major's status on the farm? (*"Status" refers to the level of respect or importance an individual is given.*)

2. Consider the following line from Old Major's speech on page 7:

"There, comrades, is the answer to all our problems. It is summed up in a single word—Man. Man is the only real enemy we have. Remove Man from the scene, and the root cause of hunger and overwork is abolished for ever."

Why does Old Major use Man as a scapegoat for the animals' conditions? (*A scapegoat is a person or group of people blamed for something bad that happens, even if it is not their fault.*)

Because they believe man is making he animals miserable and that the animals feel like slaves.

3. Consider the following line from Old Major's speech on page 7:

"[We] are forced to work to the last atom of our strength; and the very instant that our usefulness has come to an end we are slaughtered with hideous cruelty. No animal in England knows the meaning of happiness or leisure after he is a year old. No animal in England is free. The life of an animal is misery and slavery: that is the plain truth."
