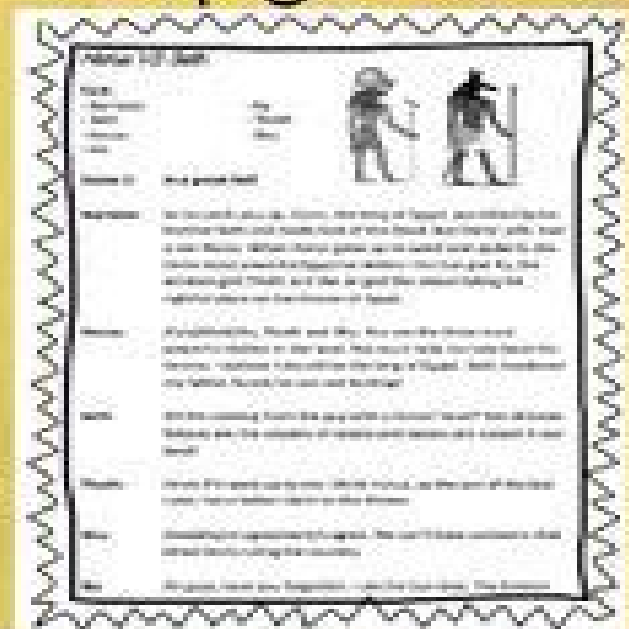

Drama Lessons In Action Antoinette Line,1997 Atlas of Egyptian Mummies in the Czech Collections II: Non-Adult Human Mummies Pavel Onderka,Gabriela Vrtalová,2022-01-01 Ancient Egyptian mummies and their funerary equipment are an invaluable source of information not only on the Egyptians perception of death but more importantly on their lives diseases and traumas they suffered from activities they carried out their family relations and more The present volume second in the series of Atlas of Egyptian Mummies in the Czech Collections is dedicated to mummies and funerary containers of non adults aged 15 and younger Two complete mummies twelve isolated parts from ten individuals and six funerary containers were introduced in a detailed catalogue along with their respective provenances and brief excursions into the health and disease of ancient Egyptian children and their funerarytreatment The studied material came from the collections of two divisions of the National Museum in Prague namely the N prstek Museum of Asian African and American Cultures and

the Natural History Museum The mummies were examined using non invasive methods and the results were compared to those published in the past The containers two boxes two hampers and two jars represent only a small part of typological repertoire of containers used for the deposition of burials of non adult individuals While the non adult mummies and their isolated parts are without provenience all of the six containers come from modern excavations at well documented cemeteries at Deir el Medina and Abusir Examination by non invasive methods especially computed tomography brought to light several findings including one possible case of traumatic death and one possible case of rickets Information on the use of mummification substances and techniques including the reinforcement of spine were also reported

Arabic Dialogues Rachel Mairs,2024-03-04 During the nineteenth century and into the early twentieth century more Europeans visited the Middle East than ever before as tourists archaeologists pilgrims settler colonists and soldiers These visitors engaged with the Arabic language to differing degrees While some were serious scholars of Classical Arabic in the Orientalist mould many did not learn the language at all Between these two extremes lies a neglected group of language learners who wanted to learn enough everyday colloquial Arabic to get by The needs of these learners were met by popular language books which boasted that they could provide an easy route to fluency in a difficult language Arabic Dialogues explores the motivations of Arabic learners and effectiveness of instructional materials principally in Egypt and Palestine by analysing a corpus of Arabic phrasebooks published in nine languages English French German Spanish Portuguese Italian Yiddish Hebrew Russian and in the territory of twenty five modern countries Beginning with Napoleon s Expedition to Egypt 1798-1801 it moves through the periods of mass tourism and European colonialism in the Middle East concluding with the Second World War The book also considers how Arab intellectuals understood the project of teaching Arabic to foreigners the remarkable history of Arabic learning among Yiddish and Hebrew speaking immigrants in Palestine and the networks of language learners teachers and plagiarists who produced these phrasebooks
