2. How do you think different people's chromosomes would compare?

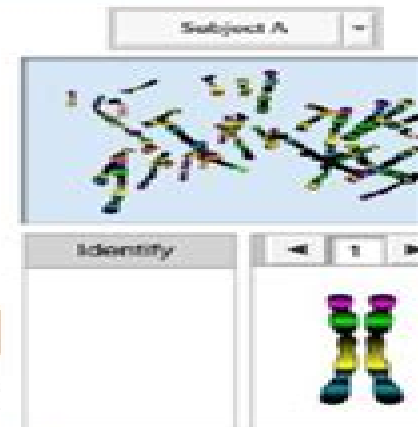
Gizmo Warm-up
