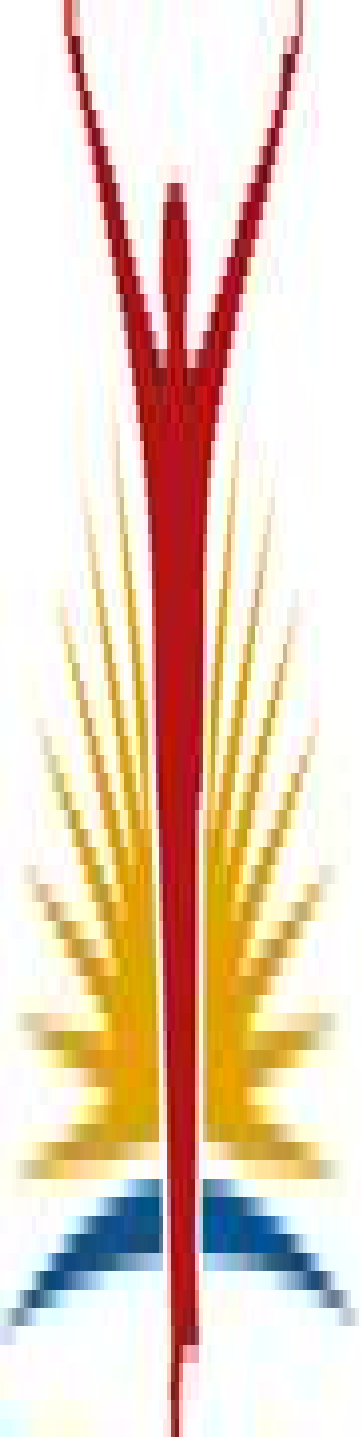

Marriages of Inconvenience Susan Booysen, 2021-12-12 Marriages of Inconvenience The politics of coalitions in South Africa is a research based volume that collates and interprets lessons that South Africa should take to heart in managing interparty coalitions It draws from domestic experiences as well as from case studies on the rest of the African continent and generic instances further afield Coalitions in various iterations have been a part of the South African polity since the attainment of democracy in 1994 This started nationally with a grand coalition in the form of a Government of National Unity as mandated in the interim constitution Coalitions have also found expression in some of the country s provinces After the transition multiparty governments were sustained at national and provincial levels either as a matter of necessity due to election outcomes or for other political considerations At local government level coalitions have been relatively commonplace in South Africa from the onset of democratically elected municipalities in 2000 with many situations where no single party attained an absolute majority This gained prominence from 2016 when many metropolitan governments and some large towns became sites of coalition politics

Andr Rose National Cancer Institute Extractive Industries and Changing State Dynamics in Africa Jon Schubert,Ulf Engel,Elísio Macamo,2018-07-04 This book uses extractive industry projects in Africa to explore how political authority and the nation state are reconfigured at the intersection of national political contestations and global transnational capital Instead of focusing on technological zones and the new social assemblages at the actual sites of construction or mineral extraction the authors use extractive industry projects as a topical lens to investigate contemporary processes of state making at the state corporation nexus Throughout the book the authors seek to understand how public political actors and private actors of liberal capitalism negotiate and redefine notions and practices of sovereignty by setting legal regulatory and fiscal standards Rather than looking at resource governance from a normative perspective the authors look at how these negotiations are shaped by and reshape the self conception of various national and transnational actors and how these jointly redefine the role of the state in managing these processes for the greater good Extractive Industries and Changing State Dynamics in Africa will be useful for researchers upper level students and policy makers who are interested in new articulations of state making and politics in Africa

Bantu Holomisa Bantu Holomisa,Eric Naki,2018-11-01 Bantu Holomisa is one of South Africa s most respected and popular political figures Born in the Transkei in 1955 he attended an elite school for the sons of chiefs and headmen While other men his age were joining Umkhonto weSizwe Holomisa enrolled in the Transkeian Defence Force and rose rapidly through the ranks As head of the Transkeian Defence Force Holomisa led successive coups against the homeland regimes and then became the head of its military government He turned the Transkei into a liberated space giving shelter to ANC and PAC activists and declared his intention of holding a referendum on the reincorporation of the Transkei into South Africa These actions brought him immense popularity and the military dictator became a liberation hero for many South Africans When the unbanned ANC held its first election for its national executive in 1994 Holomisa who had by now joined the party received the most votes beating long time veterans and party stalwarts He and Mandela developed a close relationship and Holomisa served in Mandela s cabinet as deputy minister for environmental affairs and tourism As this biography reveals the relationship with both Mandela and

the ANC broke down after Holomisa testified before the Truth and Reconciliation Commission among other issues that Stella Sigcau and her cabinet colleagues had accepted a bribe from Sol Kerzner After being expelled from the ANC Holomisa formed his own party the United Democratic Movement with Roelf Meyer As leader of the UDM Holomisa has played a prominent role in building coalitions among opposition parties and in leading important challenges to the dominant party This biography written in collaboration with Holomisa presents an engaging and revealing account of a man who has made his mark as a game changer in South African politics

Nelson Mandela Crain Soudien, 2017-03-22 The death of Nelson Mandela the great South African fighter for freedom in December 2013 prompted several colleagues within the World Council of Comparative Education Societies community to come together to think about the significance of his life and his work for education This book is the result of that coming together The contributing authors reflect on what his life the commitments he made and principally the values he took into the struggle for freedom in South Africa mean for education The point of departure for the book is that of honouring the man It begins with the argument that the values for which he stood namely the unconditional dignity of all human beings respect for difference and principally his lifelong commitment to justice have a special significance for how we as inhabitants of an increasingly connected and interdependent world conduct our personal lives our relationships with one another and with the material and living space which surrounds us It is an ecological approach As the world moves into a twenty first century where paradoxically we know so much and yet appear to understand so little and so find ourselves struggling to create social lives in which all of us can feel respected can offer respect to others and live lives free of fear and anxiety the values for which he stood have specific relevance for how we do the important job of teaching and what we put into it Mandela poses deeply provocative questions about the kinds of lives we seek for ourselves and for everybody else around us
